Interns receive a wide variety of experiences consistent with the NASP practice model. They will be placed on one campus (typically a smaller campus with 3/4 of the typical caseload) full time with 2+ hours of supervision a week. It is anticipated that supervision time will be greater in the fall and will taper to closer to 2 hours per week as the year progresses. There is also a weekly group case consult with other psychologists in the district that is encouraged for any that want to attend. Interns will be responsible for initial and re-evaluations on their campuses, participating in RTI/MTSS team meetings monthly (where data is discussed and they are an integral part of determining what interventions are needed or if moving to evaluation is warranted). Interns are part of the administrative team on their campuses and typically have opportunities to be a part of systemic campus initiatives. Interns receive opportunities for both individual and group counseling, assessing and supporting behavior (FBA/BIP/progress monitoring), completing academic interventions (assessment, instruction, progress monitoring), consulting with staff and families, and any other specific activities they are interested in. We tailor experiences to meet the specific needs/interests of our interns as much as possible. Interns attend monthly psychologist meetings that include training opportunities, as well as quarterly intern-specific trainings with their cohort in the district. LESD has an MTSS system in place for both academics and behavior, so interns are able to see examples of both general and special education practices. They are given opportunities to visit specialized programs in the district and evaluate low incidence populations as well. Litchfield Elementary School District is a Pre K-8 district. We have opportunities for interns to be placed on K-5, 6-8, or K-8 campuses, with preschool experiences also available. The district has a population to include low to high SES, ELL, and military. There is a high degree of support from district and school administration, as well as collaboration. among psychologists. Interns will feel as if they are part of a team at LESD and gain excellent experiences. We have one licensed doctoral psychologist on staff and two other doctoral level psychologists who are not licensed.
