Please briefly describe what experiences an intern in your district would receive. (consider using this section to describe what day to day internship would look like throughout the internship experience):

Our internship is designed to have an intern placed with a current psychologist from day 1. During the first semester, the intern will learn the evaluation and student/staff support processes alongside their supervisor, with the expectation that they will be able to be more independent and be assigned to cover portions of their supervisor's sites on their own during the second semester (with continuing supervision). The internship involves primarily being placed with 1 supervisor at their assigned schools, with rotation opportunities 1 day per week. The rotations are designed to change each quarter to allow our interns the ability to experience a variety of different settings and age groups. Our rotation opportunities include early childhood/preschool, elementary school, middle school, high school and a school serving our severe and profound needs population. Interns in Amphi will have the opportunity to work with their supervisor to create an experience that best fits their interests and needs, including opportunities to participate in the development of appropriate social, emotional and educational development along with behavioral management, counseling and consultation, and educational evaluations. Our district psychologists meet on a monthly basis.
