Kyrene has a long history of providing internship opportunities in school psychology, and many interns have stayed with Kyrene after their internship. The most successful approach we've had to internships in Kyrene is to strategically place students independently at one school with high levels of support and supervision and have a secondary placement at an additional site with another certified school psychologist assigned to work side-by-side about one day a week. Previous interns in Kyrene report getting a well-rounded, comprehensive experience and are confident in their skills by the end of the school year.
