**Within SUSD, interns will be placed at their own campus 4 days/week. The campuses have smaller evaluation caseloads with an emphasis on MTSS and intervention. Interns will have a dedicated psychologist available to answer questions throughout the day, attend meetings, and support with case conceptualization. Interns have reduced caseloads to allow them to develop skills as they navigate the roles and responsibilities of a school psychologist. Interns will gain experience managing their own caseload, collaborating with school teams, developing processes and procedures, and implementing MTSS. If experiences are not available on a certain campus (evaluating certain eligibility categories, running MDRs, completing threat/risk assessments, etc.), the intern will be paired with another psychologist/campus.**
