CERTIFICATION-ONLY OPTIONS

Applicants interested in the Principal, Superintendent, or Education Supervisor certification can enroll as a non-degree seeking (NDG) student to complete their academic requirements for state certification.

Certification-only options are currently offered through the UA main campus.

Interested candidates should contact the program Director for additional details and academic advisement. This advisement will include a review of transcripts and the creation of a personalized plan of study specific to each student's needs.

These options are subject to the availability of courses (when offered), and course enrollment capacity.

Once students complete their program of study, we can provide an Institutional Recommendation (IR) to help facilitate the certification process.
