CLASS SCHEDULE	Nontraditional class schedule. Courses are offered evenings and weekends.	Courses are scheduled throughout the day with occasional late afternoon classes. Typically limited to 2-3 days a week.
FINANCIAL SUPPORT	All students pay in-state tuition (regardless of being in-state/out of state). Students at Distance Campus locations pay tuition on a per unit basis. The University allows students at Distance Campuses to have a fixed tuition rate, meaning that your tuition will not increase if you stay on track to graduate with your cohort.	Opportunities are available for students to seek and apply to Graduate Assistantships within various programs on campus.
