Student & Alumni Spotlight





Brendan Feldgoise is an Arizona Online student receiving internship credit for his work as an Academy Performance Analyst for New York City Football Club, a soccer club for players who want to play at the collegiate and professional level. In this role, Brendan uses video analysis to enhance the player development process, as well as to support the head coaches on the field. Brendan also leads team meetings and works directly with individual players to look at their strengths and areas of improvement.

Alyssa Gandolph (class of 2022) is the Strategic Data and Grants Analyst for the Chandler Unified School District, the second largest school district in Arizona. In this role, Alyssa writes and manages grants, evaluates program data, and reports this data to the state. Her most recent grant was a \$1.5 million award from the Arizona Sports and Tourism Grant to specifically upgrade athletic needs at six schools.

When asked about her Leadership degree, Alyssa said this: "One of the most impactful elements of my undergraduate studies was its focus on equity – it's critical to the accuracy of my work to evaluate policies, programs, and student data not only for the average student, but disaggregated and with social, political, and historical context."

After graduation, Alyssa completed a one-year M.Ed. in Education, Policy, and Analysis from Harvard in 2023.
