  - Minimum of 3.0 GPA
- Resume or CV
- 2 Years Experience Working in PK-12 Setting\*
- TOEFL Scores (if applicable)
- Two Professional References
- Personal Narrative Statement
  - 200-500 Words
  - Highlighting past experiences, career goals and leadership
- Certification seeking applicants must also provide: Copies of their current Professional Certificate & Valid IVP Fingerprint Clearance Card.
- Small application fee (\$90)

\***Preferred requirements:** Applicants currently working in PK-12 organizations
